Free use of Staff parking	x	Drivers can use the drop off zone at the Main Entrance to drop off the patient for their appointment.		
Free use of main visitor parking	√ Take ticket and see parking attendant on exit	√ Display yellow Driver on Duty Disc in the main Car Park. There is no need to get a parking ticket. You cannot park at St Lukes using the yellow disc	√ If you park in one of the barrier car parks you must take a ticket on entry. Before you return to your car you must go to the Travel Planning & security office on level 2, show your yellow driver on duty disc and they will validate your ticket and you will be released free of charge. Don't forget there is 20-minute free car parking within the barriers that is programmed into the machines, if you are just dropping off, which allows you to take the entrance ticket and use it as an exit ticket within 20-minutes. <u>If parking office closed please go to main reception.</u>	√ Parking is now only available in the Contractors Car Park If you park in the main car park you get the first half hour free of charge.

Free use of main visitor parking	√ Display your yellow Driver on Duty disc in the pay and display car park	√ Take a ticket on entering the car park. On leaving go to the parking office in the main entrance with your ticket and your yellow driver on duty disc and they will validate your ticket and you will be released free of charge.	√ Take a ticket on entering the car park. On leaving go to the main reception with your ticket and yellow driver on duty disc and the receptionist will supply you with a free exit ticket. Don't forget there is 20-minute free car parking within the barriers that is programmed into the machines, if you are just dropping off, which allows you to take the entrance ticket and use it as an exit ticket within 20-minutes.	<p>If you go to St Georges you take the car park ticket to security in the main hospital, this is a desk back left in the concourse, show the Surrey Community Action yellow badge and they will validate the ticket. <u>The ticket only lasts for 15 minutes after validation.</u></p> <p>This appears to work but has not been agreed with Surrey Community Action.</p>

Free use of main visitor parking			You must display your Driver on Duty Disc at all times when on the Hospital Site. Volunteers can drop off at the main entrance and park in the pay and display car park free of charge but NOT in staff parking bays. This is located to the left of the entrance to the hospital by Queen Mary Maternity Unit. Please note: if you park in the barriered "pay on foot" car park you must pay for parking.	There is number plate recognition at this hospital. You must go into reception and show your yellow driver on duty disc and give them your registration number. You will not be charged.
