

Closure of Main Outpatients Car Park at St. Peter's Hospital

Between 1st October 2019 and July 2020 a new multi-deck car park will be built on the site of the current outpatients' car park at St. Peter's. The current outpatients' car park will be completely closed during the works and there will be no access for drop-off/pick-up or parking (including blue badge parking) during this time.

The overall number of parking spaces available to patients and visitors will remain the same so you should not experience any additional challenges in finding a space. From 1st October you will just need to park in a different location to usual and there will be signposting to direct you.

The map shows the available parking for patients and visitors during the works.

THREE MAIN PARKING AREAS

- 1 The main car park is marked as Hazel car park. This was previously used for staff parking but is now dedicated parking for patients and visitors
- 2 The top floor of the Abbey Wing car park
- 3 The A&E car park will be for blue badge holders only

How to access the hospital during this time...

- The lower entrance on Level 1 of outpatients will not be accessible during the works
- The main entrance on Level 2 of outpatients will remain open with normal access for visitors; however, there will be restricted access for ambulance and taxi pick-up and drop-off
- There are also alternative entrances/exits to the hospital which are marked on the map



We know that car parking can cause frustration and we apologise for any inconvenience caused during the works.
